In order to participate in the Alumni Basketball Tourney

You must adhere to the following requirements.

1. **Registration deadline: Sunday, March 14, 2010** (earlier if possible).
2. Waivers, Entry Fees, and Team Entry Forms are due by Friday, March 19, 2010 or Saturday, March 20, 2010 – depending on when your team plays (payable to Sterling Community Association).
3. **Without a waiver, you won't be playing, no exceptions.**
4. Entry Fee: \$10.00 per person. This is a fundraiser, so if you'd like to pay more that's OK.
5. Teams consist of a minimum of five (5) players. Team participants must have graduated in the same year, unless there are not enough players; then they may be from the class one (1) year above or below. Exceptions for the older classes will be aloud.
6. You must have graduated from Sterling High School to participate.
7. **Agree to and sign the waiver of liability.**
8. A Team Captain must be designated on you Entry Form.
9. Teams must have names, the wittier the better (keep it clean and appropriate).
10. Teams must have matching shirts and numbers, the zanier the better.
11. **Abide by these Codes of Conduct Rules.**
 - A. Understand, appreciate, and abide by the rules of the game.
 - B. Respect the integrity and judgment of game officials (**keep in mind that game officials are amateurs**).
 - C. Respect your opponent; congratulate them in a courteous manner whether in victory or defeat.
 - D. Be responsible for your actions and maintain self-control.
 - E. Do not taunt or bait opponents, and refrain from using foul language.
